Secondary Transition

Secondary Transition planning focuses on what a child needs to prepare him/her for a successful life after high school, and is included in the IEP starting at 14 years of age or sooner. The training overviews the components of the planning process, age-appropriate transition assessments, and required elements of secondary transition. Each family will also receive an organizational binder for their child's records.

Each family will also receive an organizational binder for their child's records.


