#### **Rent Smart Launch**

A little over two years ago Stephanie Collinsworth expressed a concern about the issues that families were having obtaining housing, including poor rental history and the lack of affordable rental housing in our region. She started digging, and ultimately found the Rent Smart program developed by the University of Wisconsin Extension office. After some additional research, we put the wheels in motion to offer Rent Smart in our schools and communities. We partnered with The Ohio State Extension Office and The Ohio State University law department to adapt the materials to fit legal requirements in Ohio. Teaching materials, workbooks, and other items were purchased with



McKinney-Vento funds with our state coordinator's blessing. Stephanie, Jenny Maze, and Penny all were trained to facilitate the program.

Tonya Buchanan and Jacque Prichard went through the program as participants so they had a better understanding of what we would be teaching. The Family Support Team set dates on October 3rd, 10th, and 17th for our first class and started to spread the word. Jenny and Penny facilitated with Tonya and Jacque assisting. While we only had one participant for this class, we all learned something from the experience. All in all we call it a success and are looking forward to our next class!

What's next for Rent Smart? Our next step is to have conversations with district administrators about utilizing the program in schools as part of the financial literacy curriculum. We look forward to serving our districts in this new and different way.
